#RIDETOBRINGTHEMHOMENOW

100 days after 7th October, join tens of thousands of people around the globe who'll be riding their bikes to highlight the ongoing plight of the Gaza hostages.

"Ride to Bring Them Home Now" is an international cycling event dedicated to raising awareness for the 129 individuals currently held hostage by Hamas. This initiative, organized by the Hostages and Missing Families Forum, in collaboration with the professional cycling team Israel Premier Tech, the Israeli Foreign Ministry, and the Israeli Cycling Federation, aims to mark the hostages' 100th day in captivity. Tens of thousands are expected to take part in individual solidarity rides and many others in the special cycling events held simultaneously at the Velodrome in Tel Aviv and several major capitals across the globe. In addition to cycling events planned for Barcelona, Paris, London, Melbourne, Los Angeles (Santa Monica and Thousand Oaks), DC, Atlanta, St Louis, Guatemala City, Hong Kong, Punta del Este, and elsewhere,

Cyclists everywhere are being encouraged to go for a ride on 14 January with yellow ribbons tied to their bikes, and to upload photos of their rides to social media with the hashtag #RideToBringThemHomeNow.

Venture to the Atlas Mountains, where you'll learn about the unique lives of rural Berber women and even discover traditional bread-making methods. Journey to the majestic Todra Gorge and explore a fossil factory. Traverse the desert in a jeep, visiting nomad settlements and local farms to understand their distinctive ways of life. Chill out in your desert camp awaits with a breathtaking sunset over the Sahara dunes, followed by a sunrise camel ride and experience the thrill of sand surfing. Details are being worked out.
